

Private Pilot License (PPL) with Instrument Flight Rules (IFR) training to meet and exceed Transport Canada requirements

Requirements:

- Private Pilot License (PPL)
- Medical certificate: Category #1 or Category #3
- Minimum Age: 17
- Minimum English level to enroll in Absolute Aviations Private Pilot License training course with Instrument Flight Rules training course : ICAO 3
- English Language proficiency upon completion to attain License from Transport Canada: ICAO level 4 or 5

Note: ICAO Level 4 or 5 is required by Transport Canada for all New Applicants applying for Private Pilots License [reference: Transport Canada Advisory Circular AC 400-002 Effective date 01-08-09]
